





The nation faces an urgent and growing need for talent. To meet that need, many more people must earn college degrees, workforce certificates, industry certifications and other high-quality credentials. That's why Lumina Foundation works to ensure that, by 2025, 60 percent of Americans hold a credential beyond high school – a quality credential that prepares people for informed citizenship and economic success.

A steady climb

Lumina tracks the post-high school educational attainment of Americans ages 25-64. Since 2008, that figure has increased by **10 percentage points.** That's progress, but it's not enough to reach 60 percent by 2025. Dramatic action is needed to meet the nation's need for talent.















Some College No Certificate/Degree Numbers by State





What is it?

- Projects total number and rates for:
 - Postsecondary enrollment
 - Credential production
 - Postsecondary-credential population

MHEC Projections Study Key Findings

Without action, gaps will persist

Increasing enrollment & completion is essential, but not enough to close gaps in attainment

Targeting a narrower age band (25-44) may be more actionable




Historical Growth:




Percentage of Persons Aged 25-49 Without an Associate Degree or Higher Who Are Currently Enrolled in College





Return rates for full-time freshmen.






Percentage of First-Time, Full-Time, Degree/Certificate-Seeking Students who Graduated within 150% Completion Time by Race/Ethnicity









Growth benchmarks for enrolling adults who do not have a postsecondary degree or credential (including those with some college)


Completion

Attainment


